SINGAARA PURASKAARA

Kannada Sangha has decided to institute “Singaara Puraskaara” (“Singaara Awards”) from the year 2000 onwards to recognise achievements of Kannada Sangha members and their immediate family members. These awards will pay special attention on the achievements of the children. The achievements in the following categories will be considered for an Award:

- Education
- Sports
- Extra Curricular Activities (ECA) - Excluding Sports

1. Educational:

- 1.1 Top class Grades at the PSLE, ‘O’ Levels, ‘A’ Levels, Diploma, Degree, Post-Graduate Courses
- 1.2 Merit Certificates / Recognition from recognised bodies in Individual Subjects, as long as the overall performance is good.
 - 1.2.1. Awards from Singapore Government for top ranking students in Mother Tongue (need not necessarily be Kannada, as students, based on other criteria like availability, and would have selected the mother tongue).
- 1.3. Other Recognised long-term courses in Languages / Individual Subjects etc.
 - 1.3.1. Like Rashtra Bhasha, Visharada examinations in Hindi, Samskrita examinations conducted by some organizations or any other courses from recognized institutions.
 - 1.3.2. Applicant should be a medal winner in these examinations.
- 1.4. Students who have been selected as a ‘President’s Scholar, or awarded ‘Rotary Club Scholarship’ etc.

2. Sports:

- 2.1. In all the recognised sports and games in Singapore and abroad.
- 2.2. Amongst the top three at Inter-School, College, University, State, Country

2.3. Consistently good performance at these competitive tournaments.

3. Extra Curricular Activities :

- 3.1. Top class achievements in Literature, Music, Dance, Drama, Arts etc.
- 3.2. Academy award winners in Literature and Cultural topics.
- 3.3. Top ranks in examinations conducted by recognised organisations.
- 3.4. Music examinations conducted by the Singapore Indian Fine Arts or other similar organisations in Singapore, and abroad.
- 3.5. Music examinations conducted by the Government of Karnataka or recognised examinations of similar standard.
- 3.6. Representing University, State or Country in prominent events and won laurels.
- 3.7. Representing the country as a Cultural Ambassador.

4. General Guidelines:

- 4.1. These Awards are open only to the members (all category of membership) of the Sangha and their immediate family members. Definition of immediate family members is “spouse and children” of the member.
- 4.2. Parents and unmarried siblings of the member who are living with the member at the time of their achievement may also be considered in case of exceptional achievements.
- 4.3. To be eligible for awards candidates or their parent should be an existing member at least since 30 days prior to the declaration of the “Achievement”. Only exceptions being those memberships/renewals processed in January of each year. For example, an applicant whose “Achievement” was announced in July 2001 will not be considered for the award if the applicant or applicant’s family enrolls as a new member or renews the membership either in July 2001 or later.
- 4.4. The Award/s will be annually distributed at Rajyothsava/Deepavali function.
- 4.5. The Achievement considered for award is from the preceding calendar year.
- 4.6. Nominations for the awards:
 - 4.6.1. Completed applications in the prescribed forms have to be submitted to

the Sangha soon after the “Achievement” is announced.

- 4.6.2. Copies of supporting documents along with a recent passport sized photograph should also be submitted along with the application
- 4.6.3. The members can either download the application form from the website OR request for a copy by writing to the Sangha and enclosing a self-addressed envelope.
- 4.7. The Committee will announce the list of “Singara Awards” a fortnight prior to the “Rajyothsava/Deepavali” celebrations day. The winners will be informed by e-mail or normal post at least one week before the function.
- 4.8. Applications that are incomplete, incorrect or provide false data will be strictly rejected without any further correspondence.
- 4.9. The decision of the Sangha will be final and no further correspondence will be entertained on this matter.
